Ans. Here's an example conversation for a class 3 student about their daily routine:

Partner A : Hi! Let's talk about what we do each day! What do you usually do in the morning before school?

Partner B : I wake up around 6:00 am with my mummy's help. Then I brush my teeth and get dressed in my uniform. Sometimes I pick out my outfit the night before!

Partner A : Great! I wake up at 7:30 am too. I have breakfast with my family, maybe cereal or pancakes! Do you eat breakfast before school?

Partner B : Yup, I always have some toast, milk and fruit to get me going! After breakfast, do you pack your lunch or does your mom help?

Partner A : My mom packs my lunch most days, but sometimes I get to pick a sandwich or a fun snack to bring. What about you?

Partner B : My mom packs my lunch too! She always writes me a cute little note to find inside. Okay, so what happens at school?

Partner A : During school hours, we have fun classes - reading, writing, math. We do art, sing songs, play games at recess. Your fav subject?

Partner B : I love reading time! We get to hear stories and learn new words. What about you? (Continue the conversation discussing favourite classes, lunch break activities, etc.)

Partner A : After school, what do you typically do?

Partner B : When I get home, I have a snack like cookies or fruit. Then I might play with my toys or watch a little TV before starting my homework. Do you have any homework to do after school?

Partner A: Yup, I usually have some reading or math problems to do. Sometimes my teacher lets us take them home to finish. In the evenings, I might help set the table for dinner or play outside with friends. What do you do in the evenings?


